## A New Vision for Road Usage Charges

- Motorist Choice of Reporting Methods. Enable motorists to choose the methods and technologies for reporting their mileage
- **No Mandate for GPS.** Enable options for wireless reporting of undifferentiated mileage from the odometer subsystem and differentiated mileage from technologies with vehicle location capability
- Open Technology Platform. An open system for data collection that allows technologies to evolve with motorist preferences
- **Public Private Partnerships**. Tap into market forces to allow the public to *choose* either government or private sector provision of onvehicle technologies, data collection and payment services.





## What is an open system?

An open system is an integrated system based on common standards accessible by the marketplace whereby components performing the same function can be readily substituted or provided by multiple providers
